Agenda

Meeting called to discuss how preparations for the start of the season were going in relation to GMS. With GMS experiencing technical issues, guidance from them has been given as to priorities for clubs to action.

Officials/umpires/club admins, team admins can now register

Club Admins

Club Admins have now been appointed. MS, LH, CV, RR and HM have now or are in the process of registering as Club Admins.
Club Admins initial priorities will be:-

- ✓ to focus on updating fixture times and venues and ensuring officials in place
- ✓ Allocating Team Admins (these will be team captains)

Team Admins

Team Admins will need to register themselves as a player on the GMS system first. Please let MS know when registered and Club Admins will then approve them as Team

Admins. Dave Saxton to be asked if he could be a Team Admin for the 8s, and Lizzie Lamb to be a Team Admin for the 7s.

Panels

MS has now set up each team as a panel on GMS, Ladies 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8 plus panels for junior teams U14/U16/U18 requested by RR. Players can be in more than one panel. Panels should enable quicker selection for matches by Team Admins.

Umpires

Contact has been received from another club through GMS requesting we bring one umpire to our away match. Concern made that if we provide umpires for away matches as well as fulfilling our obligation under GMS to provide two umpires for home matches that there will not be enough to go around. Discussed potential to make reciprocal arrangements if numbers allowed.

Contacts

On GMS the club has been consolidated into Belper HC. Contact info for ladies to be updated. LH to be added as fixtures contact for BLHC in place of Nick Morris.

Rules

Discussion about whether players will be able to play for different teams on the same day and RL will share league rules email. Consensus was that 4s,5s,6s,7s, can play for each other. LL mentioned that there are goal keeper problems in 6s,7s,8s making matches potentially looking ropey due to numbers. Would league matches take precedent over friendly matches if this was the case?

Spreadsheet of adult players to be shared with captains showing availability of players to aid selection in the lower teams.

Process for matches this weekend (18th September)

GMS has relaxed regulations and the requirement to organise fixtures, teams etc through the system due to the technical issues experienced. Suggestion that home and away team players names could be written down along with the match result and signed by both teams to agree.
