## **Match Day Protocol**

At Belper we strive to provide a friendly and welcoming atmosphere for our members and visitors alike. and it would help us tremendously if players could -

Ensure that membership and match fees are kept up to date.

Advise captains in good time if you are unavailable for any reason and arrive promptly and stay for teas afterwards both home and away wherever possible.

Always have red and white socks with you just in case of a colour clash.

Ensure that you take any litter away with you from the pitch!

You won't be charged match fees if providing refreshments however it is your responsibility to:

- Ensure that the water heater is turned on before the match, it will normally have been done by the 1<sup>st</sup> team of the day!
- You must ensure that you wash your hands in the right-hand sink in the kitchen and ensure teas are set out promptly and drinks are provided to all opposition, umpires and your own team mates.
- The teas provided must be enough to feed 2 teams, there is nothing worse than coming out
  of the shower to find that there is no food left! They are not usually provided for visitors
  and/or family members.
- At the end of teas ensure that all cups and plates are collected and if plates are particularly dirty they need to be rinsed first before putting in the dishwasher. The kitchen and clubroom should be left as you found them and tables are wiped down. If there is any food left over ensure that it is disposed of and do not assume that the next team will eat it.
- If for some reason you cannot stay to clear up please delegate someone else to do it in your place so that it is not just left!
- Unless you have been bar trained please do <u>NOT</u> serve alcohol! Find someone that can!
- If you are last in the clubhouse please ensure the water heater, oven/hob, extractor fan and room lights are switched off (the kitchen lights go off automatically), set the alarm and shut the front door and green gate behind you!
